## Call to Artists

### BANNER PROGRAM

The City of Whittier Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department is seeking artists to participate in the sixteenth annual Community Street Banner Program. Local artists of all ages are asked to submit scaled down drawings for consideration to be painted onto banners that will be hung throughout the city.

### GUIDELINES

- Submitted designs should measure 5 inches by 14 inches (keep in mind this is not to scale) and vertically oriented.
- Artists should take into account that these banners will be viewed from a distances of 8 to 30 feet or more.
- Inappropriate or obscene language or images are prohibited.
- Artists may submit a maximum of two designs.
- Artists must live, work, or go to school within the City of Whittier.

### THEME

We all have dreams. Dreams are unique and important to each person. No two people have the same dreams. Some of us have big dreams. Some of us have small dreams. Some dreams come true quickly and other dreams take a lifetime. Dreams can be personal or they can represent multiple things.

How big do you dare to dream?

### CREATING A BANNER

- 100 artists will be selected.
- Selected artists will be provided with a vertical banner which measures 30 inches by 104 inches or 24 inches by 60 inches.
- The banner should be painted on ONE side with acrylic paint. (Painting supplies are not provided)
- The artist's signature can be placed on the lower right hand corner of the painted side.
- The banners become the property of the City of Whittier and are available for purchase (tax-deductible).
- All proceeds go back to the Community Street Banner Program.
